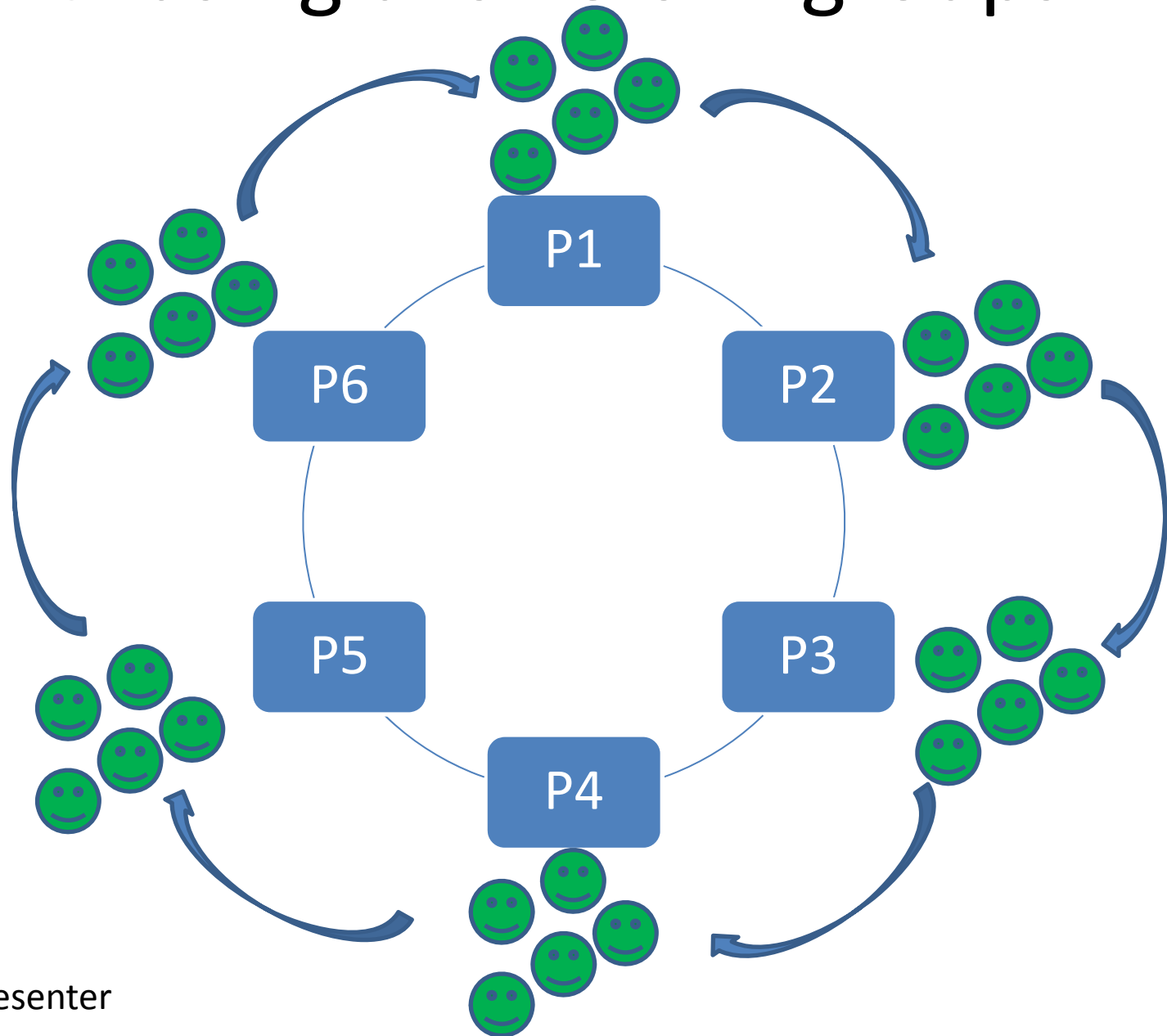

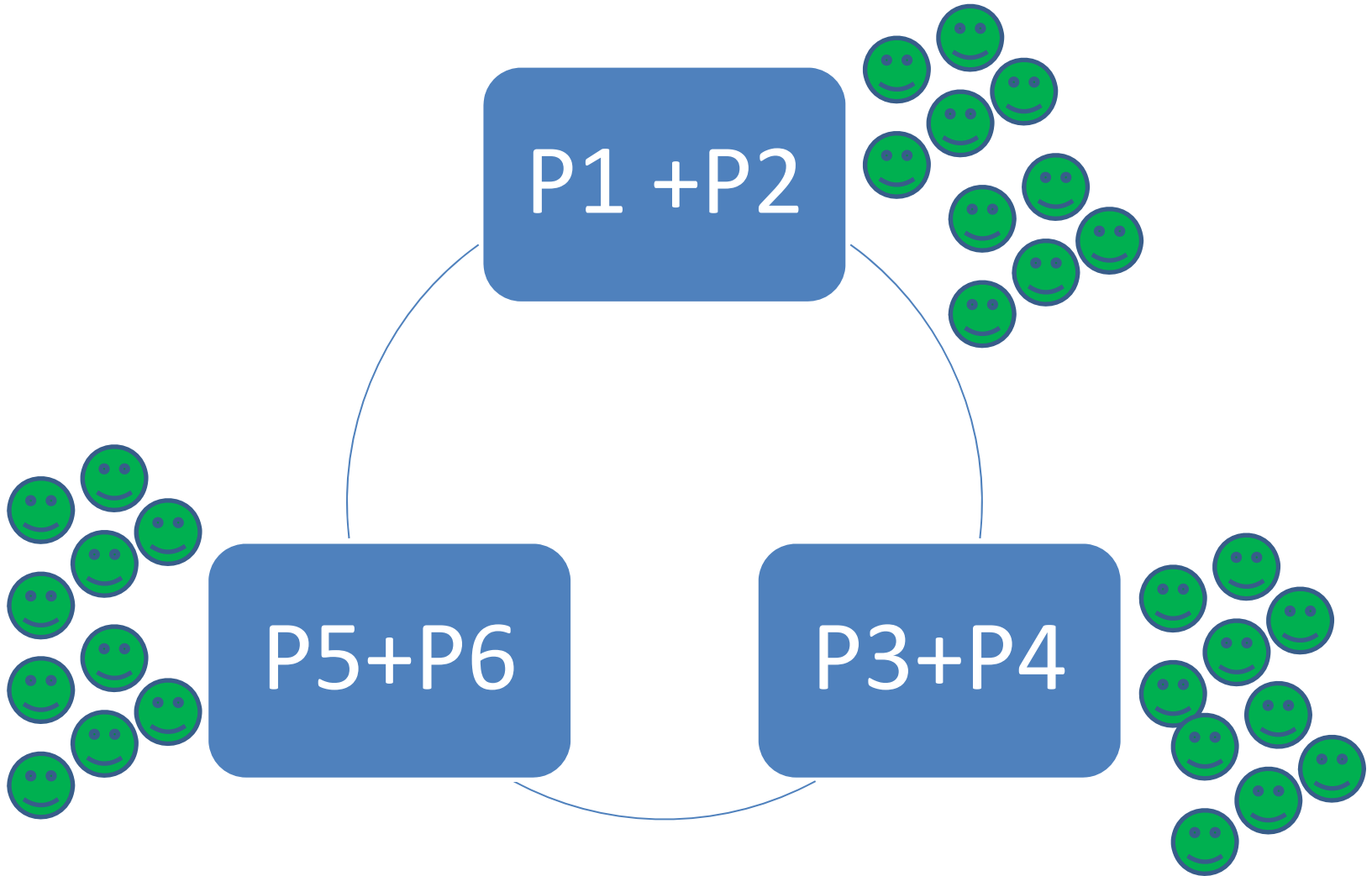





Each group: 2 major lessons learnt

Lessons learnt, Group 1

- Focus, priorities
- Planning for Quality Management
- Buy-in from all stakeholders
- Alignment with overall university strategy

Lessons learnt, Group 2

- Change "development"  effort
- Transformation  As opposed to management
 - Top down
 - Bottom up
 - Not an overlay, but a framework for the way we operate
- EU Qualifications Framework
 - Accreditation for prior learning
 - Build on experiences from other countries, regions
